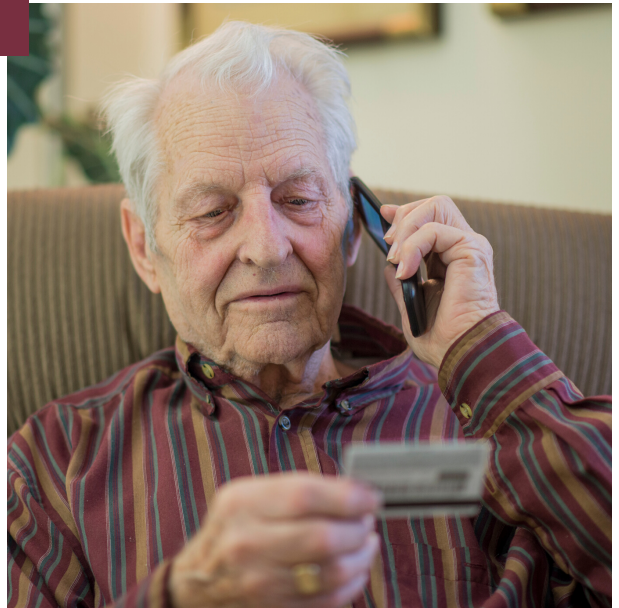
COVID-19 TESTING



Free, drive-thru COVID-19 testing is still available at Basil Griffin Park in Bowling Green this week. Pre-registration is no longer required. To register on-site, you must have a valid ID. These calls vary from scammers asking for donations to a fake charity, giving you fake news updates, and even offering free COVID-19 test kits.
